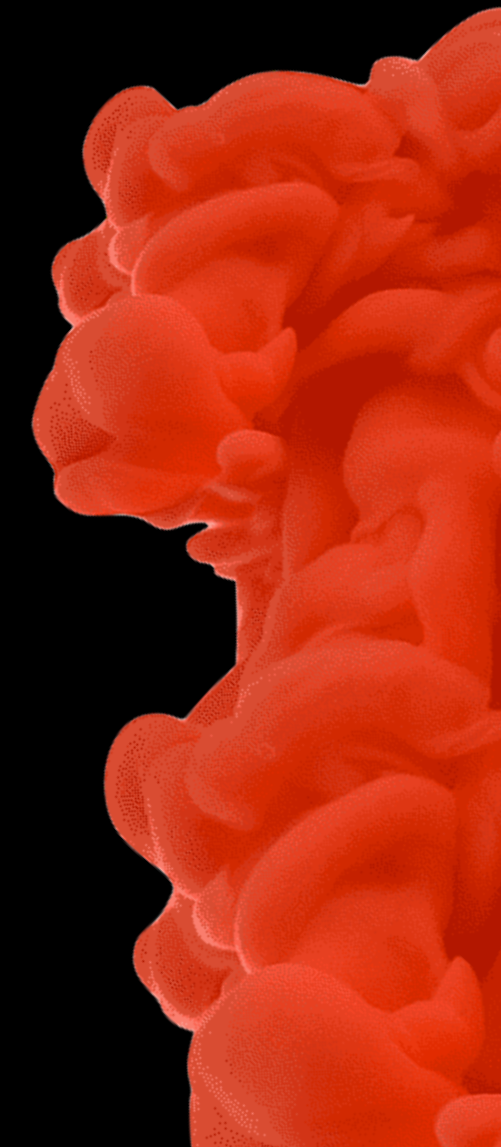

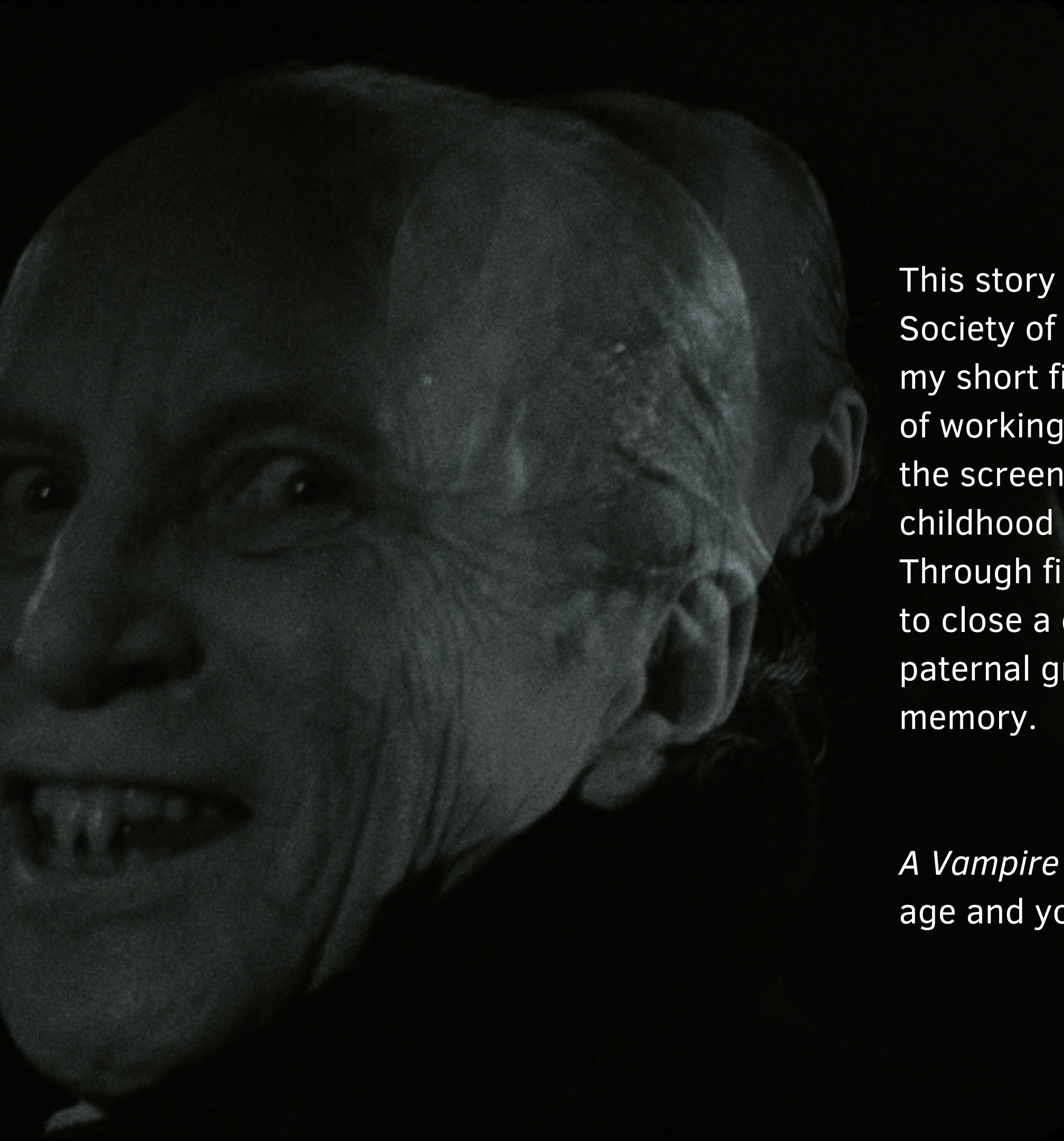
LOGLINE & SYNOPSIS

Logline: After some hints made by his older cousin, Diego will have to find out if his grandfather is a vampire or not.

Synopsis (short): Diego is being looked after by his older cousin Rodrigo for the rest of the afternoon, who implies that their grandfather is a vampire. Diego will have to gather the courage to discover if it is true that he is a blood-sucking being.

Synopsis (long): Diego, a seven-year-old boy, is in the care of his older cousin, Rodrigo, while the boy's father takes grandfather Basilio to the hospital. During the afternoon, strange things happen in the house and Rodrigo hints that their grandfather is a vampire. After thinking about it, Diego believes him and he will have to summon the courage to discover if it is true that Basilio is a bloodsucker who wants to bite him and his father.





DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

This story was born while taking classes at SOGEM (General Society of Writers of Mexico). After the experience gained from my short films, *CAYO* (2018) and *Diego & Pug* (2022), and years of working in advertising, I decided to bring these characters to the screen with *A vampire at home*. This is a story about childhood loss and how much it means while growing up. Through fiction and a team of industry professionals, I was able to close a duel that took me many years: the death of my paternal grandfather, Basilio. This short film is dedicated to his memory.

A Vampire at home is a combination of comedy and drama; old age and youth. A representation of life itself.



BIOGRAPHY

Mauricio Tinoco was born into a middle-class family in Mexico City. He studied Communication at Universidad Iberoamericana from 2013 to 2017. His short film *CAYO* (2018) obtained the Laudatory Mention from the same institution. In addition, it was an Official Selection at the Fabriano Film Festival 2018 in Italy and at the Eleventh Mostra Escolas de Cinema Ciba-Cilect at the Latin American Film Festival in Brazil. His second short film, *Diego & Pug* (2022) was an official selection at the Vertifilms Festival in Tijuana, Mexico. He is currently part of Nauta Media, a Content Marketing agency focused on the production and post-production of visual and audiovisual content. Recently, he won the Angular Script Festival with his most recent short film script *While we grow up*, organized by the Angular rental house. The president of the jury was Guillermo Arriaga. Mauricio is in the process of finishing his first feature film script.



PRESS NOTES

A vampire at home is a Production from Lomito Pictures. It had a total cost of USD \$3,500.

The short film features a special performance from by Juan Carlos Colombo, a Mexican-Argentine actor who has stood out in films such as *Five days without Nora*, *More than anything in the world* and *Herode's Law*.

A vampire at home was filmed over 4 days in Mexico City.

The short film is set in the early 2000s. References appear throughout its duration, bringing back memorable memories for children of that time.

Alex Z. Reynaud, renowned mexican cinemtaographer is an Associated Producer of the short film.

A vampire at home has several Executive Producers, including Arturo Jaramillo, who plays Diego's father.

Iker Lotina, the leading actor of the short film, has many credits on Mexican television in both series and soap operas. *A Vampire at home* is his film debut.

Mario Palmerín, the actor who plays Rodrigo, won the audience award at the Morelia International Film Festival for his performance in the feature film *Animo Juventud*.
